- increasing the detection of crimes against the credibility of documents (under Articles 270 and 275 of the Penal Code)










Art. 42 OF THE ACT ON PUBLIC DOCUMENTS of November 22, 2018

Norway grants

1. A public official who performs, within the scope of his competence, activities on the basis of presented or submitted public documents, gets acquainted with the data and information referred to in art. 46 par. 2 points 1-3 [graphic files, document description, graphic files with security features].

2. The public officer referred to in par. 1, **checks the authenticity** of public documents in terms of the first level of verification referred to in art. 7 par. 4 point 1 [without the use of technical equipment].

3. The public officer referred to in par. 1, **verifies the authenticity** of public documents also within the second level of verification referred to in art. 7 par. 4 point 2 [with the use of generally available devices magnifying or emitting UV radiation], if it has devices that magnify or emit UV radiation.
